RE: Lunchtime Arrangements

As you will be aware, for the first two weeks of term we requested that all S1 students remain within our campus and grounds at interval and lunch times. As of Monday 4th September, we are happy to allow your son/daughter to venture offsite – if you feel confident that they are ready to manage this safely. We would be grateful if you could discuss this with them, and agree what you are comfortable with.

Any student who leaves the campus at interval and lunchtime should be mindful that they are representing their school, and we expect them to do so with pride. Please encourage your son/daughter to maintain a high standard of behaviour, interact respectfully with members of the public and wider community, and to ensure that they use pavements and pedestrian crossings in order to remain safe. It is also very important that any litter or waste is placed in bins etc., and that no mess is left behind.

Our school catering service will continue to offer a range of healthy and cost effective meals and snacks, and these can be eaten in the canteen or Barra areas, or ordered as a take away snack. More information on this can be found on the Aberdeenshire Council website, along with details of how to top up your son/daughters card online. Please check back regularly in order to see what is available, as this changes on a seasonal basis.

We have a range of extra-curricular clubs and activities which run at lunch times and at the end of the school day. These are advertised through our bulletin notices, and posters around the school. Our daily bulletin is posted on the school website each day, and so please do read these so that you are aware of what is available and can encourage your son or daughter to take part. Whilst time to relax with friends at lunchtime is important, we would encourage all young people to try the clubs and activities which are of interest to them.
