## **New S4/S5/S6**

- **New S4 / S5 / S6 Induction:** - As our new S4 / S5 / S6 return to an important Senior Phase Year, we will be having a short Induction Assembly on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> June for each year group in turn.

After the bell rings to signal the end of extended registration (09.10), All new S4 students should be directed to the Assembly Hall – the Induction Assembly will then last until the end of Period 1 (09.40).

At the beginning of Period 2 (09.40), all new S5 students should go to the Assembly Hall where they will have an Induction Assembly. This will finish at approximately 10.05.

At 10.05 all new S6 students should be directed to their SQA and Common Rooms where they will gather to be escorted to the Assembly Hall for induction. This will finish at break time (10.30).
