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Head Teacher Update

S3 Options

237 Pupils with allocated options

170 (72%) with no reserves (or 172 if we include the 2 with '2' reserves used)

64 (27%) with 1 reserve

17 had to provide one other choice as reserves did not work for them.

1 pupil joined the school and reserves were not needed (post allocation)

3 with 2 reserves (1 gave same reserves as choices, 1 pupil subsequently changed their mind about their subjects, each did get their 5 first or revised choices)

S56 Options
281 met the choice deadline
22 missed the choice deadline

222 pupils (73%) needed no reserves 69 pupils (23%) needed one reserve 12 pupils (4%) needed 2 reserves

7 Pupils chose FA creative and digital media and had to be recourse affecting 2 columns (FA and work placement), but some were able to switch to another FA so are not included in the 12 above 4 Pupils were unable to secure a place in the FA Construction. Several were able to switch to FA Auto.
