- 5. Leave time to browse around all the stands. You may just find some others interesting.











What To ASK?



Regarding Jobs:

Qualifications – Which subjects and at what level?

Applications – At what age can you apply, at what time of year and by what means? (Letter/CV/Form)

Interview – What procedure is followed to select staff?

Training – What type of training is given?

Prospects – What are the chance of advancement?

Salaries – What is the estimated salary of a trainee?

Opportunities – What are the opportunities locally/nationally?

Preparation – What personal qualities are looked for? What can I do to prepare for this type of job, other than acquiring qualifications?

Regarding Courses:

- Qualifications What is required for entrance to the course at present?
- Applications How and when to apply for the course? What is the selection procedure?
- Length What is the duration of the course?
- Links Are there other courses which may interest and suit me?
- Prospects What type of work does the course lead to? What vacancies exist? What is the salary structure?
- Could I use this qualification to diversify to other countries, other work?
